

Product News:

****Coke Farms organic Baby Mixed Head Lettuce is gapping to start the week. The previous heat damaged the crops that were close to maturing. The new, sequential planting may start this week. We are filling in with conventionally grown Artisan Mix from Tanimura & Antle in Monterey.**

****Comanche Creek's Heirloom Tomatoes became very limited at the end of last week due to previous heat damage. We will fill in with Coke Farm's Mixed Heirlooms as needed. Straight pack heirloom tomato supplies will be hit or miss this week.**

Avocados: Supply is tight, and price is up this week. CA fruit is moving from Southern to Central Coast area as season winds down. Mexican supply is very tight. Old crop is done, and new crop is expected to start sometime in August.

Berries:

Blackberries – Supply will continue to be limited for another week or two but should ramp up by the last week of July. Production is expected to peak in August as both CA and Northwest will have good volume.

Blueberries – The extreme heat in the Northwest affected supplies and growers continue to assess damage and pack best fruit available.

Raspberries – Production in Watsonville is steadily increasing each week and quality has improved.

Strawberries – Peak production in Watsonville/Salinas is passed. Supply will be steady for the next 6 weeks but due to the recent heat, quality will be hit or miss and showing some bruising and mis-shaped berries.

Brussels Sprouts: Supply is limited due to quality, we rejected the last two deliveries from Mexico last week. New crop from Salinas will start this week but please be aware that sizing will be inconsistent, and price will be elevated. Half Moon Bay season is expected to start sometime in August.

English Cucumbers: The heat in Mexico and CA has caused quality issues such as decay and shorter shelf life. Product is limited and only 12 ct packs are available at this time.

Melons: Full Belly Farm's Organic Mixed Melons are in stock this week with straight packed Goddess and Orchid melons. More varieties will follow soon. For conventional product CA grown cantaloupes and honeydew melon supplies have improved and prices are back to normal. CA grown seedless water-melons supplies are limited and prices are up due to lack of labor available to harvest them, coupled with high demand.

Peas: Organic English Peas from Coke Farm are finished for the season and we are limited to stock on hand. Iacopi English peas are gapping, and may be done, due to dry weather.


